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## You Will Need

Size of Scarf		Yarn Requirements
Short Scarf	14cm wide x 120 cm long (approx. depending on tension)	1 ball RIOT DK by King Cole
Longer Scarf	14cm wide x 185 cm (approx. depending on tension)	2 balls RIOT DK by King Cole
5.00 mm crochet hook (tension is not important to this project) Adjust you hook size to achieve the drape and feel you are happy with.		



Ch(s) chain(s): st(s) stitch(es) sl st: slip stich: Tr treble: RS Right Side:



Note: Before commencing, we recommend you put aside about 5 metres from the start of the ball to complete the edging on this end. This will ensure the yarn is a reasonable colour match for the first row of your scarf.

Make 33 chains.

## Foundation row:

2tr into 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from hook, \*miss 2 ch (1tr, 1ch, 1tr) into next ch, miss 2 ch, 3tr into next ch. Repeat from \*to end. Turn

## **Pattern Row:**

2ch, 2tr into 2nd st, \*miss 2 tr (1tr, 1 ch, 1 tr) into next ch space, miss 2 tr, 3 tr into next tr, repeat from \* to end, working last 2tr into 2nd last st and 1 tr into the last st (turning chain from previous row). Turn.

Repeat Pattern Row until approximately 5 metres of yarn remains. Work edging as follows.



## Simple Cluster Edging:

\*Ch 10, sl st to 1st st, ch14, sl st to same st as before, ch10, sl st into the same stitch. Sl st across next 5 stitches, repeat from \* to end of row, working last cluster of chains in last stitch of row.

Rejoin yarn set aside before commencing scarf to other end and work Simple Cluster Edging to this end in the same manner.
